



MANFRED MANN STAR RELEASES NEW SINGLE

And it's been almost 50 years!

Mike Hugg, best known as the drummer in the chart-topping Manfred Mann has linked up with Hampshire songwriter, Gethyn Jones, to produce what the pair hope is a great feel-good summer song for 2018.

The single, **OZONE**, is performed by **RedLIPZ** – a band of studio musicians, including singer Amba Tremain.

The song, written by Gethyn, is inspired by the stunning views across the Solent from Stokes Bay, Gosport in Hampshire. (One of the UK's best kept secrets.) Both Mike and Gethyn were raised in the town.

Mike Hugg is still playing and touring with **The Manfreds** – who had 16 Top Twenty singles including **5-4-3-2-1** (which Mike co-wrote), **Do Wah Diddy Diddy**, **Mighty Quinn**, **My Name Is Jack**, **Semi-Detached Suburban Mr James** and many others. Mike teamed up with Manfred to write hundreds of award-winning TV jingles. He also composed the theme tune to the **Whatever Happened To The Likely Lads**, the much-loved BBC TV show and composed and recorded the music for the motion picture **Up The Junction**.
